ABOUT THE ORGANIZATION

Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. is a private, non-profit organization whose purpose is to provide assistance and support through established programs in local communities throughout the world. The sorority currently has 1,000 collegiate and alumnae chapters located in the United States, Canada, Japan (Tokyo and Okinawa), Germany, the Virgin Islands, Bermuda, the Bahamas, Jamaica, West Africa, Southern African, United Arab Emirates, and the Republic of Korea. The major programs of the Sorority are based upon the organization's Five-Point Programmatic Thrust:

- Economic Development
- Educational Development
- International Awareness and Involvement
- Physical and Mental Health
- Political Awareness and Involvement

The Sorority was founded in 1913 by 22 collegiate women at Howard University to promote academic excellence and provide assistance to those in need. The Founders of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority envisioned an organization committed to sisterhood, scholarship, service and addressing the social issues of the time. Since its founding, Delta Sigma Theta has become one of the preeminent service-based sororities with more than 350,000 initiated members .

As a sisterhood comprised primarily of Black, college-educated women, the Sorority seriously considers the issues impacting the Black community and boldly confronts the challenges of African Americans and hence, all Americans. Over the years, a wide range of programs addressing education, health, international development, and the strengthening of African American families have evolved.

Who We Are Locally

The Orange County (FL) Alumnae Chapter (OCAC) of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. was chartered on May 28, 1983. With a desire to revitalize Delta's Five-Point Programmatic Thrust, the women of Orange County (FL) Alumnae Chapter use their organizational skills and education to enhance the civic and social development of the residents within Orange and Osceola counties. Since its inception, OCAC has remained committed to stellar service and delivery of award-winning public service programming that has resulted in more than \$183,000 in awarded scholarships and incentives to graduating students, programming services for at-risk students, programming enabling community members to have access to tools and services that provide them with financial freedom, as well as resources to improve their physical and mental health. This program focuses on incentive awards while introducing the honorees to society, exposing them to workshop training in the areas of economic development, educational development, international awareness and involvement, physical and mental health, and political awareness and involvement.

Young high school juniors and seniors - male and female - have participated in this education-focused program, which encourages and supports academic achievement, while providing a life changing experience in areas such as etiquette, professional development, financial management, college preparation and tours, and physical and mental health awareness. By recognizing high achieving junior and senior students for outstanding scholastics, extracurricular involvement, and participation in community service endeavors, we have successfully provided approximately \$183,750 in support of continued education.
